Open Source Software

Development of FOSS Applications

GFOSS in collaboration with the FOSS Community, and as mentor organization in Google Summer of Code, contributes to the development and expansion of FOSS applications that are useful for businesses, the public sector and the educational community. Overall 40 FOSS projects have been localised and developed. All the projects that have been developed under GSOC are available at https://go.eellak.gr/gsoc.

FOSS Conferences

GFOSS participates and organises every year several conferences with lectures and workshops held by both Greek and foreign speakers. The goal is the information, dissemination and exchange of knowledge and new developments related to Free/Open Source Software, Open Content and Open Technologies. GFOSS organises on a yearly basis the MoodleMoot conference (moodlemoot.ellak.gr), The Scientix Panhellenic Conference (scientix.ellak.gr), supports the FOSSCOMM conference (fosscomm.gr) and organises workshops on Open Source Technologies.

Open software in education

GFOSS through the edu.ellak.gr initiative, promotes actions for Open Technologies and Open Content in education. In collaboration with hundreds of teachers, has created registries of open source applications that are used in primary, secondary and tertiary education.

Aiming to promote STEAM and Educational Robotics through Open Technologies and Open Software in Primary and Secondary Education, a Scientific Committee has been set up by members of the academic-research community. The task of the Scientific Committee is to contribute to the demarcation of STEAM epistemology in the educational community through actions and publications, and to coordinate as well as to develop STEAM teaching material for teachers (https://edu.ellak.gr/epistimoniki-epitropi-).

Open Content Initiative

The aim of the initiative is to support the creation of open educational content and consists of two key actions:

- -Awareness raising on the issues of open content and the use and edit of educational content and demonstrating the collaborative example of Wikipedia and Openstreetmap through seminars, workshops and educational projects.

The Greek Free/Open Source Software Society (GFOSS) is affiliated with the Creative Commons organization. The CC licenses were transferred to the Greek law and translated into Greek in 2007. Since then, efforts have been made towards the promotion of CC licenses among artists and educators, emphasizing the cultural paradigm shift of sharing intellectual creations. Many actions have taken place over Government agencies for releasing public data over a Creative Commons license, letting citizens participate and using them for services and more.
